GERTRUDE HAWK FUNDRAISER

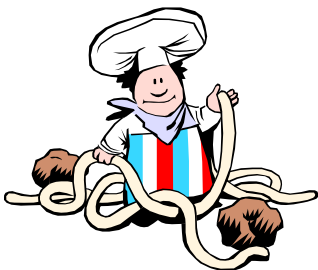
