PANCAKE BREAKFAST

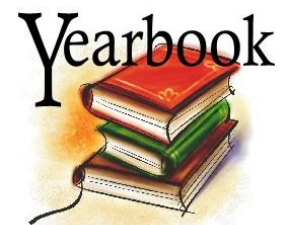
